InFocus is a practical and supportive education group for families and carers supporting people with mental health, alcohol and other drug, and gambling use.

Developed by SHARC Family Drug and Gambling Help, InFocus offers practical support, relevant information, coping strategies and the opportunity for people to connect through their shared experiences. The program is facilitated by professionals who have also been impacted by someone's mental health, alcohol and drug use, and/or gambling.
